Chan Wai-Yee obtained his B.Sc. from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1974 and Ph.D. in Biochemistry from the University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida in 1977. After a two year Genetics fellowship, he joined the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Oklahoma Health Science Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, first as an Assistant Professor and then a tenured Associate Professor. In 1987-1989, he was also appointed to be Associate Member, Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation, Oklahoma City. He became Professor, Department of Pediatrics, Georgetown University, Washington, DC in 1989. He remained there as a tenured Professor of Pediatrics and Adjunct Professor of the Departments of Biochemistry, Molecular and Cellular Biology till October, 2009. He also served as Chief of the Division of Genetics and Metabolic Diseases from 1998-2000 and Director of the Molecular Genetics Diagnostic Laboratory from 1993-2000, at Georgetown University Medical Center. In 2001, he was seconded to the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD), National Institutes of Health (NIH) to found the Laboratory of Clinical Genomics. He was appointed as Head and Principal Investigator of the Section on Developmental Genomics, NICHD, in January 2006 while taking a leave of absence from Georgetown University. He assumed his current position as Professor of Biomedical Sciences and Director of the School of Biomedical Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, the Chinese University of Hong Kong in June of 2009.
