 - (c) Three CUHK Engineering Professors elected Fellows of the prestigious Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers in the class of 2023;
 - (d) Two out of the three Hong Kong scholars to receive the honour of Tencent's New Cornerstone Investigators were from CUHK; and
 - (e) Business handled by the Vice-Chancellor under delegated authority.
