The proposed revisions to the procedure of the Fitness to Practice Committee with effect from 1 July 2025 were approved.

The proposed changes to the penalty guidelines of the University's *Procedures for Handling Cases of Academic Dishonesty* were approved.

The proposed revisions to the Guidelines on the Use of Artificial Intelligence Tools in Teaching, Learning and Assessments were noted.

The proposed revisions to the *Regulations Governing Undergraduate Medicine Programme* applicable to students admitted in 2025-26 and thereafter were approved.

The technical amendments to the Regulations Governing Associate Students were noted.

The recommendations of the Committee on Re-approval of Self-financed Taught Postgraduate Programmes on 16 self-financed taught postgraduate programmes were approved.

The 2023-24 annual reports from the following committees, supplemented by the verbal reports of the respective Chairpersons, were received:
