- was formally established in 1966;
- offers in the academic year 2022-23 through 60 Graduate Divisions a total of 224 (including 3 offshore) programmes leading to higher degrees, postgraduate diplomas and certificates.

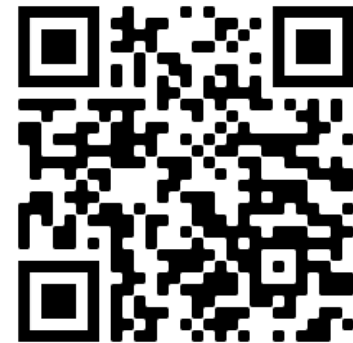
