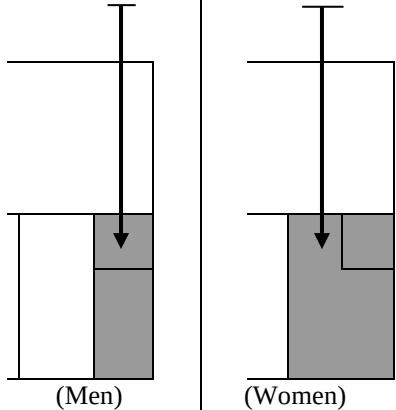
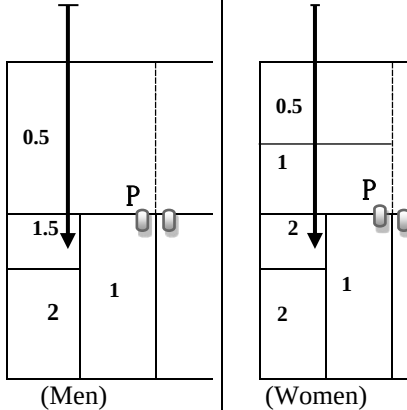
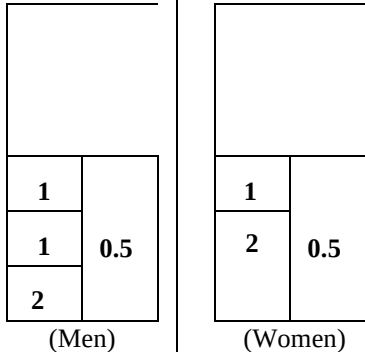

	Examinee forehand drives the ball bouncing up from the floor straight to the front wall in 55 seconds and controls the ball to land on or behind the forehand service box (for men) or forehand back quarter court (for women) (see diagram below). The first 5 successful drives will be awarded 2 points per drive, and the following successful drives will be awarded 0.5 points each. A total of 15 accumulative successful hits is required for a full score of 15 points. Three balls will be provided to the candidate who shall start driving behind the Short Line. Volleys and backhand drives will not be counted.		Students work in pairs. The feeder feeds 10 balls (8 out of 10 serves will be counted), one by one, to the front wall with a racket or by hand for the candidate (P) driving at the backhand front court. The candidate shall start each drive from the T position and at least one footstep on the Short Line. The distribution of scores per drive is shown in the diagram below. The feeder shall feed behind the Short Line on the same side as the candidate. Other members in the court shall help pick up balls on the floor to secure the safety of the feeder and the candidate.		Examinee serves 5 Lob Serve from each Service Box. Each side will count the best 4 out of 5 serves. The diagram below shows the distribution of scores.
