

# TYPHOON / RAINSTORM ARRANGEMENTS

| Weather Condition   | Arrangements   |

| <b>Before Classes/ Activities</b>                                   |  |
| Typhoon Signal No. 8 (or above) /<br>Black Rainstorm Warning Signal | If either of the signals is hoisted or in force at or <b>after 7:00am</b> , all morning classes and activities before 12:30pm will be cancelled.<br><br>If either of the signals is hoisted or in force at or <b>after 11:30am</b> , the afternoon classes and activities after 12:30pm will be cancelled. |
| <b>Classes/ Activities in Progress</b>                              |  |
| When Typhoon Signal No. 8 (or above) is hoisted                     | Classes/activities will be suspended immediately. Students <b><u>should stay in a safe place or go HOME/ back to HOSTEL</u></b> immediately if conditions permit.  |
| When Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted                      | Classes/ activities <b><u>held indoor</u></b> will be continued.<br>Classes/ activities <b><u>held outdoor</u></b> will be suspended immediately. Students are advised to take shelter at a safe place and remain there until it is safe for them to go home or go back to hostel.                         |

Contingency arrangements about activities in case of typhoons or rainstorms will be announced as soon as possible through e-mail.

On campus transport arrangements under bad weather:

1. Normal school shuttle bus service between the New Asia College and University MTR Station and Shaw College and University MTR Station will be maintained for an hour of the hoisting of Typhoon Signal No. 8 (or above).
2. Normal shuttle bus service will be maintained even when Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force unless situation does not permit.
