Major Programme Requirement

Students are required to complete a minimum of 90 units of courses as follows:

Explanatory Notes:

1. All LAWS courses, excluding courses labelled as △ and LAWS2220, will be included in the calculation of Major GPA for honours classification.
 2. Students can opt to use the “Chinese Law (Summer Course)” (LAWS2201) successfully completed at the Tsinghua University to fulfill 3 units out of the 6-unit University Core Chinese Language Requirement in which case LAWS2201 will not be counted towards the fulfillment of elective courses requirement.
 3. Exemption from 6 units out of the 9-unit University Core English Language Requirement will be granted if a level of 7.0 is attained in IELTS upon graduation.
 4. In addition to Major Programme Requirement and University Core Requirement, students are required to take 13 units of non-law electives.
- ▲ Students who opt for the Study Option: King’s College London Study Abroad Programme will be required to take LAWS4001 to substitute for LAWS4010 in order to fulfill the capstone requirement. Students who have successfully completed the Optional Modules of 120 credits offered by KCL’s Masters of Law Programme will be granted course and unit exemption for up to 18 units of Major Elective Courses.

[a] Graduation Thesis II (SOCI4020)

- The Graduation Thesis should have a strong component matching the theme of the particular concentration in order to fulfill the requirement of that concentration area.
- If a student declares to take two concentration areas, units earned from the course “Graduation Thesis II” will be counted towards the fulfillment of the requirement of one area only, subject to the course supervisor’s endorsement. The student should indicate towards which area the units are counted when declaring the concentrations.

[b] Directed Studies I/II (SOCI4410/4420)

- The Directed Studies should have a strong component matching the theme of the particular concentration in order to fulfill the requirement of that concentration area.
- If a student has taken SOCI4410 and 4420, and both are of the same theme that can be counted towards the fulfillment of the requirement of one concentration only, then only up to 3 units from either one course can be counted towards the fulfillment of the concentration requirement, also subject to the course supervisor’s endorsement.
- If a student has taken SOCI4410 and 4420 with different themes, subject to the course supervisor’s endorsement, the units earned from SOCI4410 can be counted towards the fulfillment of the requirement of one concentration and SOCI4420 towards another.
- Units earned from a directed studies course can only be counted towards the fulfillment of the requirement of one concentration.

Explanatory Note on mutual recognition or exclusion:

1. The 13-unit non-law electives can be used to satisfy both the requirements of the first and second degrees.
